The B.A. and B.S. degrees in Economics provides a foundation to explain how people, business, and governments make decision with limited resources. The Economics majors are built on a foundation of strong theoretical and statistical training. The majors provide students a solid grounding in microeconomic and macroeconomic theory, statistical and econometric methodology, as well as applied economic analysis. The Economics majors emphasize the role of incentives and institutions in shaping economic outcomes and how public policies influence economic performance and individual outcomes. In addition to having a solid understanding of economic theory, our program has a special emphasis on economics, political economy, law and economics, and environmental economics, empirical methods, and U.S. economic history.

Graduate Program Opportunities

> Our students have the opportunity to work as research assistants with the faculty on cuttingedge research projects which make them competitive for graduate programs. Students who are interested in pursing graduate work in Economics have the opportunity to pursue the quantitatively rigorous Economics, B.S. major which will prepare students for graduate level study. UC Merced graduates in our program have been admitted to graduate programs in Economics at Institutions such as UC Irvine, UC Merced, UC Santa Cruz, and Texas A&M. Our students have also been accepted at law schools including University of Michigan, UC Hastings Law, University of San Francisco, and Duke University.

Internship Opportunities

Recent Economics students have had great success in securing internships working in a wide field of positions including finance, sales, marketing, management consulting, and data analysis. Some of the firms that have offered our students internships include Amazon, Vanguard, Merrill Lynch, Morgan Stanley, Goldman Sachs, Gallo, Foster Farms, L'Oréal, TTI, and PG&E.
